

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

All dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate in this trial.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under **four** months of age are prohibited from the trial grounds.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. M.A.D. Agility's equipment is within all specs to AKC requirements. 24" spaced weaves, break-away tires and contacts rubberized. Ring sizes will be 100' x 100' for both rings.

1. NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES PERMITTED ON SHOW GROUNDS.

- 2. All dogs must <u>be on leash</u> when not competing in the ring or at the practice jump.
- 3. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.
- 4. Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are familiar with AKC agility rules and regulations and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- 5. Telegraph, telephone, email, AKC online entries, fax, and unsigned entries will not be accepted.
- 6. All calls to the Trial Secretary must be before 2 PM Mon Fri or 9am-9pm Sat / Sun.
- 7. Entries not on official AKC entry forms or photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules printed on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT acceptable and will be returned!
- 8. Postdated checks and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The club treasurer will add a collection fee of \$20.00 to the amount of each returned check.
- 9. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms. Entry fees do not have to be refunded in event of such error.
- 10. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs at the show site. Failure to do so will result in dismissal.


